Incident 1: On the 22nd of June Friday nightshift at around 00:49 in the early hours of Saturday morning the officer was doing an external patrol in the yard. As the officer was approaching the corner where the RU unit is, they first heard and then saw a lorry arriving to that corner where the industrial gas tanks were and where the officer was about to turn. Given the lighting conditions, the officer decided it would be safer if they walked around the tanks from the inside (towards the walls of the building), giving bigger room for the lorry driver to turn the corner. As they walked behind the tanks they tripped over the metal protective casing of the attached wiring (they lead to a control/monitoring unit in front of the tanks), and in doing so twisted (partially dislocated) their right knee. At the time though painful it appeared to be a minor injury. Gareth Haines, regional supervisor, visited the victim that evening. It was reported that no medical attention was sought, there were no restrictions in duties, the victim continued working and felt able to continue working i the future. Incident 2: The victim was packing away cricket mats, and when lifting one they felt a pull in their back. The victim reported this incident and was advised not to continue with this activity.
